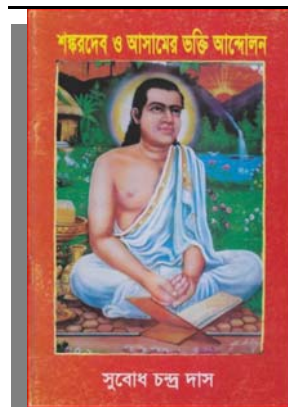


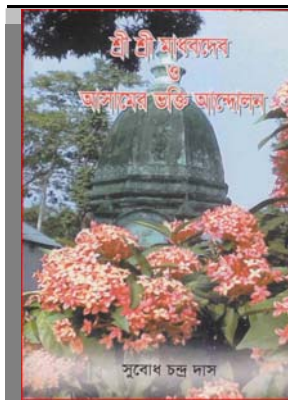
BOOKS PUBLISHED BY SANKARDEVA FOUNDATION BANGLADESH

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In the heydays of the Sankaradeva Movement, places like Rangpur and, possibly, even Dhaka had been the great centres of the propagation of the Teachings of the Saint and Madhavadeva had received his education under Rajendra Adhyapaka at Banduka (in Rangpur District in present-day Bangladesh) which was also the native place of his elder brother Damodara who held an important administrative post there.

Capt. Edward Tuite Dalton (1815-1880) of the Hon'ble East India Company had noted in his paper on the "Mahapurushyas" (JASB, 1851) that "the Mahapurushyas are widely spread

throughout lower Asam, extending into Cooch-Behar and N.E. Rungpore (north-western Bangladesh) [...] They also muster strong in Gowalparah and CoochBehar, and are found, I believe, even in the Dacca district”.

It is very nice and re-assuring to know that now that great tradition of Sankaradeva and Madhavadeva is being revived in Bangladesh through the pioneering efforts of this active group



and we pray to the Guru so that He favors them with His Blessings and Grace to emerge successful in their noble endeavour.
